E-Verify Modernization Thursday, March 22, 2018 2-3 p.m. (Eastern)

United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) invites you to participate in a teleconference on **Thursday, March 22, from 2-3 p.m. (Eastern)** to discuss the upcoming release of <u>E-Verify</u> system enhancements. During the session, representatives from USCIS will share information about the new E-Verify case processing functions and modernized user interface. This includes:

- enhanced usability features;
- a streamlined process for creating and managing cases to increase the speed and accuracy of verification results;
- modernized data matching process to reduce Tentative Nonconfirmations;
- improved overall data integrity and system compliance; and
- transfer of case data to a new modernized system.

E-Verify will launch enhancements the week of March 26. Our session will cover these enhancements with a question-and-answer period to follow.
